

Sale Terms and Conditions

1. All announcements at the time of sale shall override catalogue information.
2. Each buyer is responsible for obtaining a buyer's number before bidding.
3. All cattle shall be paid for prior to loading or other written arrangements approved by Seller.
4. Females selling as pasture exposed are not guaranteed bred. Seller does not guarantee the service sires on bred females.
5. Seller shall not be responsible for accidents to livestock after the animal is announced as "sold" by the auctioneer.
6. Seller shall not be responsible for accidents.
7. Seller reserves the rights to 200 units of semen on all bulls, calves, and yearlings. Seller shall pay the collection fees.
8. Seller shall provide a bill of sale and health certificates shall be available for cattle traveling out of state.
9. Buyer agrees that any dispute which might remain unresolved related to any sale shall be subject to arbitration to be held at a mutually agreeable site and if none can be agreed upon then in Jones, County, Texas.
